STEP-BY-STEP GUIDE

TO TAKE A GREAT PORTRAIT HEADSHOT USING AN IPHONE

SETUP

- Find a simple, uncluttered background
- Use the same background for each Team Member
- Use natural light if possible near a window or outside is ideal. The subject should stand about 2-3 feet away from the background to create depth. Position the subject facing the light source

CAMERA SETTINGS

- Open the Camera app
- Switch to Portrait mode (if available on your iPhone model). Ensure you're using the rear camera for best quality.
- Keep the camera at eye level or slightly above
- Subject should be 3-8 feet from the camera

COMPOSITION

- Frame from just below the subject's shoulders to above the head. *Center the subject*.
- Look directly at the lens for a professional look
- Keep shoulders relaxed and slightly angled
- Tilt your chin slightly down to avoid unflattering angles

TECHNICAL TIPS

- Tap the subject's face on the screen to set the focus
- Adjust exposure by sliding up/down after tapping
- Take multiple shots with slight variations

COMMON MISTAKES TO AVOID

- Don't shoot in direct sunlight
- Avoid busy or distracting backgrounds
- Don't position yourself too close to the camera
- Avoid harsh overhead lighting
